The Academy will be hosting an international family night, it will be quite a celebration. Following is an explanation of how international night will work. Admission for the night will be \$5.00 per person. Tickets will be issued to each family on a first-come first-served basis. There is a limit to the number of people the school auditorium can hold. Each family that plans to attend this event needs to purchase their tickets in advance. Tickets will not be sold at the door.

As with our past international nights, each family that will be attending the international night will indicate on the attached planner form the cooked food dish they will provide. You will need to bring sufficient quantity of that food dish to feed the number of people included in your family group. You will also need to bring a dessert, enough for your family group.

You may bring whatever you choose. If your selection does not appear on the attached form, just write it in the box marked "other". Naturally, the meal you bring may be an old favorite, a

traditional native dish, something of ethnic flavor, or it can be an American favorite. The choice is yours, but we can bet that the food we see and share that night will be delicious!

Our food will be placed on common buffet-style tables. At meal time, each family will have the option of choosing their own food, or sampling some of the delicious cuisine of our fellow school families.

Decorations, plates, cups, napkins, forks, spoons, water and sodas will be provided by the Home Academy Association: it will not be necessary for you to bring these items.

A ticket reservation form/food planner is attached. Please fill it out and return it with your oldest child as soon as possible. Please be sure to indicate what food dish and dessert you will be bringing.

To add a little excitement to the evening, we will hold a number of raffles, in addition to door prizes. If you wish to donate a new item that would be suitable for either a door prize or a raffle prize, please complete the appropriate attached form. Please note: even if you are unable to attend our gala evening, you may contribute a prize for that raffle if you wish.
